

Professional Agency Self-Tape Monologues

Shortlisted actors will be sent a request to submit a self-tape. The self-tape will consist of a 30-second monologue. The monologue will be in character, for the character the actor is auditioning for. Business casual attire will be required for all self-tapes.

It is recommended that actors spend time reading and thinking about the Character Breakdown for their character. In addition, it is strongly recommended that actors read the Pilot Script and the "Vision for the Series". Having read these documents will give actors a better understanding of the general feel and style for the web series.

Doing the recommended reading will greatly increase actors' chances of booking the role they are applying for.

Below you will find the monologues for the Professional Agency self-tapes.

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM - DAY

Orlando Cruz is sitting at the conference room table with a CLIENT. Orlando is explaining how he got to where he is professionally.

ORLANDO

It wasn't easy. The job was very stressful. But you know what they say, if you love what you do, you'll never work a day in your life.

(beat)

After a while I figured, what the hell let's do it. So here I am. My own agency. It was a risk. A risk I'm glad I took. So that's the story of Graphic Solutions Associates.

(beat)

We offer a wide suite of graphic design services. I'm here to help you find the solutions that are *right* for your firm.

INT. OFFICE RECEPTION AREA - DAY

Alex Iverson is talking to the RECEPTIONIST at the office of a potential client. He is trying to get in contact with the business owner.

ALEX

I'm doing great, thank you! I'm Alex. Alex Iverson, Account Executive. I'm here on behalf of Graphic Solutions Associates.

(beat)

We are a graphic design agency, and I would like to introduce myself to the owner. If it's okay with you, could you please put me in contact with them?

(beat)

We have a lot of graphic solutions that I just know the owner will love. We help business owners with what is *right* for their business.

(beat)

Would you happen to know if the owner is here right now?

INT. GRAPHIC SOLUTIONS ASSOCIATES OFFICE - DAY

Chase Rogers is on the phone with a supplier. He is discussing an invoice. Chase has no idea what an invoice is.

CHASE

I hear what you're saying. I just want to make sure I facilitate the payment of this invoice. Properly.

(beat)

Check? What do you mean check?

(beat)

Oh! A check... Now I get it. So how exactly are we going to check and facilitate the payment of this invoice?

(beat)

What? Send a check? Do you think that'll work?

(beat)

Okay. So... Yes. I will now send an invoice and facilitate a check. Thusly. Thank you for your help.

INT. GRAPHIC SOLUTIONS ASSOCIATES OFFICE - DAY

Anthony LeTrois is standing next to his desk. He is telling a COWORKER a story about computers. Anthony knows very little about computers.

ANTHONY

Then he told me he didn't get the email. And I was like, wow that's so weird! I'm gonna go check with the computer and see what's up with that.

(beat)

Then I went to the computer. As Digital Designer I'm pretty good with computers. So I figured I'd just ask the computer.

(beat)

So I was like, computer what happened to the email?

(beat)

And I couldn't believe it, but the computer was like, Anthony the email didn't work!

(beat)

Then I just did the email work. And it all worked out for everyone. Thanks to the computer.

INT. GRAPHIC SOLUTIONS ASSOCIATES OFFICE - DAY

Valen Lorenz is standing in front of a printer trying to fix it while talking to a COWORKER. Fixing printers is a job for tech support, not the Print Producer, but Valen does not know that.

VALEN

The printer uses ink for printing. It also uses the paper. I see we have paper. Also, I see we have all the inks here.

(beat)

"C" for cyan, "M" for magenta, "Y" for yellow, and "K" for Kblack. All the inks and paper are here. So I'm glad to inform you that the printer is, in fact, working.

(beat)

I have no idea why it isn't working. Because it is working. And don't listen to Ashley when she tells you that you are selecting the wrong printer. That makes no sense. There is only one printer here. What other printer could you possibly select?

*Note for actor: To say "Kblack" just say black but pronounce the letter "K" at the beginning of the word.

INT. GRAPHIC SOLUTIONS ASSOCIATES OFFICE - DAY

Daunte Peters is talking to a COWORKER about copywriting. Daunte knows next to nothing about what copywriting is.

DAUNTE

Most people seem to think that a Copywriter copies write. It's actually the opposite. The Copywriter writes copy.

(beat)

The copy needs to be written a lot. It's super important. It's like one of the most important graphic solutions here.

(beat)

Orlando gets it. If you look at him, you'd think he's good at copies write. But he doesn't actually copies write, he writes copy.

(beat)

So I write copy. A lot. And also, really good.

INT. GRAPHIC SOLUTIONS ASSOCIATES OFFICE - DAY

Ashley Williams is helping a COWORKER with a computer. Other than Orlando, Ashley is the only person in the office who knows how computers work.

ASHLEY

It's a good practice to save often. You really wanna make sure you save as often as you can. But it's not the end of the world if you forget to save. That's actually a common misconception.

(beat)

If you forget to save and you lose the file, you can always recover it. It's pretty easy. It's like the first thing that comes up. But it's like super stressful when you forget to save. 'Cause you think you lose the file. But you actually don't. It's always there.

(beat)

And you need to remember to select the right printer. I don't know where that other printer even came from to be honest. But it shouldn't be *too* confusing since the name of the printer is on it.

INT. GRAPHIC SOLUTIONS ASSOCIATES OFFICE - DAY

Kristine Johnson is explaining to a COWORKER what her job is as the Office Manager.

KRISTINE

Hi! I'm Kristine! It's Kristine Johnson with a 'K'. I'm the Office Manager. It's really nice to meet you!

(beat)

If you are ever out of office supplies. Please just let me know. That's my job. I do the office supplies ordering. When employees run out.

(beat)

I order them on the computer. Which is fine. Orlando says it's better that way. I don't know why we can't just go to the store. I order them on the computer. When you need more. Let me know. Thanks!

INT. GRAPHIC SOLUTIONS ASSOCIATES OFFICE - DAY

Karen Tsu is talking about project management to a COWORKER. Karen has no idea what a Project Manager does. Also, Karen is not Japanese and has never been to Japan.

KAREN

The Project Manager is actually held in very high regard in traditional Japanese culture. They are considered to be very powerful... By the Japanese.

(beat)

In Japan, most people are not allowed to even speak to the Project Manager. It's a sacred position. If anyone talks to her. Or him... It's for culture that it's not good.

(beat)

And questions... The Project Manager questions... That's not Japanese at all. It's like how Valen is always talking about Pokemon. Pokemon are not Project Managers, but they are Japanese.
